この基準は、知的・身体あわせて、日本代表としての選考基準である。

 パンパシフィックパラ水泳選手権大会(以下、「パンパシパラ水泳競技大会」 とする。)の参加基準を満たし、当該連盟が定めた派遣方針などを満たすもの。

- 2. 派遣方針
 - (1) 2018年 IPC ライセンス登録がなされていること。
 - (2) 2018 パラ水泳春季記録会兼パンパシパラ水泳競技大会代表選 手選考会において、当該連盟が定めた派遣標準記録を突破した もの。
 - (3) 派遣標準記録は、別紙2参照 特例事項ー リレーチーム結成のため、別紙2の派遣標準記録 を達成していない選手を参加させることがある。
 - (4) (1)~(3)を満たすもののうち、選手個人の能力だけでは 判断せず、日本代表が目指す方針への理解度、他の選手との協調 性や調整能力等、日本代表として最大のパフォーマンスを発揮 できるという下記の視点を含めて総合的に判断する。
 - ・日本代表選手行動規範を遵守できなかったもの
 - ・チームワークを乱す行動をとったもの
 - その他日本代表チームの目標に対して不利益と思われる行動および言動をとったもの



Pan Pacific Para Swimming Championships 2018 - August 9-13 QLD, Australia

Swimming Australia would like to invite National Paralympic Committees and National Swimming Federations to join us at the 2018 Pan Pacific Para Swimming Championships in Australia.

Meet Information:

The Pan Pacific Para-Swimming Championships is hosted every 4 years by Australia, Canada, Japan, and the USA. The event is open to invited federations to attend.

Historically, the event attracts up to 19 countries and runs a Paralympic swimming program of events over five days. Events are run as multi class heats and single or combined class finals. Medals awarded by class. Heats will be seeded by time and gender irrespective of class.

The last event was held in August 2014 in Pasadena, California, USA.

The event is held in a 50m long course pool and is open to swimmers from invited federations who hold an international sport classification and meet the published entry time standard for their event and class.

Athletes with National classification only will only be allowed to swim in preliminary events but will not progress to finals and times will not be submitted to World Para Swimming. Federations may choose to incorporate national only classified swimmers in relays, however these times will not be official and medals not awarded.

This event will be governed by the current World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations see; <u>https://www.paralympic.org/swimming/about/rules-and-regulations</u>

As event host; Swimming Australia shall have jurisdiction over all matters not assigned by the rules to the referee, judges or other officials and shall have power to postpone events and give directions consistent with rules adopted for conducting any event (World Para Swimming Rule 1.1).

Accommodation: All individuals and teams are responsible for their own accommodation. Swimming Australia will provide a list of suitable options and will explore providing all in one packages should you wish to take up this offer.

A local Tourism website <u>http://cairnstouristinformation.com.au</u> may provide further assistance.

Travel: All individuals and teams are responsible for their own travel. Swimming Australia will provide local contacts for transfers for visiting teams upon request.

Travel Visa's or documentation to travel to Australia – please contact host if you require supporting documentation.

Classification: International classification will not take place at this event. World Para Swimming Licenced athletes with 'Confirmed', 'Review', or 'Review 2018' status will be eligible to compete and progress to finals.

Awards:

Finals will be conducted in all events swum at the 2017 World Para Swimming Championships. A swimmer must place in the top eight (8) in their class during preliminaries to advance to the final. Only three swimmers per country may progress to the final. Competitors in events that are not on the eligible event list for the 2017 World Para Swimming Championships can swim during the preliminary sessions only. (If 2020 schedule of events known this will be used). In the case that an event is completed by only three (3) or fewer swimmer's medals will be awarded following the "minus one rule".

Nations Trophy:

A weighted scoring of results based on number of competitors will be explored to award a trophy to the winning nation. Scoring system to be consulted and agreed between Australia, Canada, Japan, and USA.

Event Entry Process: TBC

The final entry deadline is 26 July, 2018. Entry by number must be supplied by 9 June 2018. (Late entries may be considered at the discretion of meet management, but will be assessed a late fee of \$100 Australian dollars in addition to the event registration fee.

Competitors will be charged a \$200 event registration fee for accreditation. This fee will cover unlimited event entry. There will be no additional fee for relay entry.

Entry Information:

Competitors must meet the MET (Meet Entry Time) to be eligible to enter. The MET will be based on the 30th time (or penultimate time if less than 30) in the WPS rankings for the period 1 January 2017 until 31 December, 2017.

All team staff (i.e. coaches, medical, managers, etc.) will be charged a \$100 fee per accreditation.



Each national team must provide a list of coaching staff and support staff to host by entry by number deadline of 9 June 2018.

Lost accreditation will be replaced at a cost of \$50.00 per accreditation. Note: The Accreditation Card remains the property of event host Swimming Australia and can be withdrawn, with immediate effect, at sole discretion of the host.

Technical Meeting:

10am, Wednesday 8 August, 2018. Meeting will be held at competition venue.

Doping Control Procedure: TBC

Drug Testing will be conducted by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) and will follow WADA policies and procedures.

Blood Lactate Analysis National teams wishing to do Blood Lactate Analysis during the Pan Pacific Para-Swimming Championships must apply to the Host by June 9, 2018

Video Race Analysis and Photography

National Teams wishing to undertake Video Race Analysis or take photographs during the Pan Pacific Para-Swimming Championships must apply to the host by June 9, 2018. Accreditation will need to be worn always when taking video or photographs during the competition and training.
